



How to Give?

Types of Bequests:

- General
- Residuary
- Specific
- Contingency

- Make a list of organizations or causes that you would like to support.
- 2. Make a detailed list of your assets.
- Set up an appointment with your financial analyst or attorney, or planned giving officer at the organization you intend to support.

Warren and Jannette were born and raised in Minnesota. Warren worked for 3M and purchased Mandersheid Company, a primary distributer of 3M's abrasive materials products in the Midwest. Jannette's father and mother owned a summer home on Otter Tail Lake that the family enjoyed. Upon retirement in 2002, they made their home in Fergus Falls.

Warren loved curling and was appointed the Director of Finance for what is now the World Curling Federation headquartered in Perth, Scotland. This provided an opportunity for the Lowes to travel and participate in many of the Winter Olympics. Warren was active in Rotary International which supports service to others and strives to "... advance world understanding, good will and peace"

Jannette loved to sing and music was very important to her.

Both were lifelong learners who cherished libraries and their mission. Warren used his fundraising skills to help raise funds for the library expansion. Jannette died in September of 2020 and Warren died in February of 2022. A portion of the funds donated by the Lowe's estate was donated to the Fergus Falls Public Library Foundation for the creation of an Arts and Culture collection honoring their memory.
